Week 4:

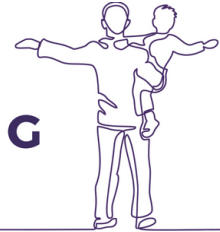
Watch in Wonder! Let's watch the children play and talk about what we see
