- Work with EarlyON Educator to prepare the environment, welcome parents, engage with families, and return the room to its original state after each session.
- Establish a safe, inclusive settings that fosters a sense of belonging where educators work in partnership with families.
- Create and maintain an environment that protects the health, security and well-being of children and families
- Support inclusion of children and families with differing abilities, vulnerabilities, Indigenous, and Francophone families, working collaboratively with their parents/caregivers and appropriate support services.
- Develop and implement an emergent curriculum applying core concepts of a Reggio inspired philosophy, using Ontario's pedagogy for the Early Years : How Does Learning Happen?
- Provide an environment that engages parents and caregivers as co-learners and leaders.
- Provide programming that reflect the view of children, parents, and caregivers as competent, capable, curious and rich in potential and experience.
- Utilizing a variety of teaching techniques including modeling, active listening, observing, questioning, demonstrating and supporting
- Observing children for the purpose of creating documentation and learning opportunities that promote development within social, emotional, cognitive, language, sensory and physical domains.
- Maintain a healthy and safe adult working environment for themselves and others
- Perform other duties as assigned by the supervisor
