Job Description/Responsibilities:

- Prepare the environment, welcome children and parents, engage with families, and return the room to its original state after each session.
- Create and design new program ideas collaboratively with Supervisor.
- Establish a safe, inclusive settings that fosters a sense of belonging where educators work in partnership with families.
- Create and maintain an environment that protects the health, security and well-being of children and families
- Support inclusion of children and families with differing abilities, vulnerabilities and working collaboratively with their parents/caregivers and appropriate support services.
- Create an environment that reflects the Developmental Relationship Framework that engages parents and children as co-learners and leaders.
- Apply core concepts of a Reggio inspired philosophy into programming
- Provide programming that reflect the view of children, parents, and caregivers as competent, capable, curious and rich in potential and experience.
- Utilizing a variety of teaching techniques including modeling, active listening, observing, questioning, demonstrating and supporting
- Maintain a healthy and safe adult working environment for themselves and others
- Perform other duties as assigned by the supervisor

- Bachelor of Early Childhood Education or ECE Diploma or other relevant Diploma/Degree
- ECE's must be registered with the College of Early Childhood Educators
- Knowledge of Developmental Relationship Framework, an asset
- Experience working with children and families 0-12 years of age is considered an asset
