MCRC is currently seeking CPA qualified candidates for a minimum 2-year commitment to:

- Act as the Treasurer, chairing the Finance Committee in monitoring expenditures and income through the monthly statements
- Report to the community and stakeholders by submitting the annual Financial Report at the Annual General Meeting
- Oversee the development and observation of the organization's financial policies
- Support and provide guidance to the Executive Director in accordance with the Board of Directors By-laws
- Provide expertise and advice in the development of the overall strategic direction of the organization
- Support and assist in the development of philanthropic resources and fundraising efforts; attend MCRC fundraising events
- Understand and influence, where necessary, public policies that affect MCRC
