LUCKY ME Prize Raffle 2024 Terms and Conditions

- You must be at least 18 years of age or older to participate and to claim the prize. Ontario residents only.
- The LUCKY ME raffle prize is a \$1,000 Wal-Mart gift card.
- Ticket cost is \$20 each with only 250 tickets available for sale.
- Tickets can be purchased in person from MCRC staff at the following locations during operating hours:

Payment methods accepted are cash, debit and credit.
- Ticket sales will commence on March 1, 2024, and cease on April 4, 2024.
- The winner will be determined with a live draw of the ticket. The winning ticket will be physically drawn by MCRC's Executive Director, Becky Andrade on April 5, 2024.
- The draw will be held at the Milton Community Resource Centre at 410 Bronte Street South, Milton, Ontario on Friday, April 5, 2024, at 11:00 am. Winner is required to arrange a pickup of the prize at 410 Bronte Street South, Milton, ON
- The personal information of participants will only be used to contact and present the prize winner. All personal information will be destroyed after October 5, 2024.
- The winner of the ticket will be notified at the time of the draw by a phone call. If an MCRC employee cannot contact the winner directly, an MCRC employee will contact the alternative contact provided at the time of ticket purchase, if available.
- An employee of MCRC will try several times to reach the winner. MCRC will keep a record of all attempts made to contact the winner.
- When a prize is not claimed by a winner within a reasonable period of time, and where all reasonable attempts have been made by MCRC to contact the winner, the unclaimed prize shall be held in trust by MCRC for a period not less than twelve (12) months from the date the prize was awarded. At the end of the twelve (12) month period the total amount of the prize held in trust shall be included by MCRC in the gross proceeds from the lottery event.
- The staff in charge of the raffle and other people involved in its conduct must not purchase tickets. This also extends to their immediate family members living in their household (spouse and children).
- The draw is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with any social media platform used throughout the contest.
