No matter what the weather

Stamp, Wiggle, Jump, Dance, Sing etc

Cinnamon Bun

One, one cinnamon bun (hold up one finger)

Two, two chicken stew (two fingers)

Three, three cakes and tea (3 fingers, pretend to eat cake and tea)

Four, four I want more (4 fingers)

Five, five honey from a hive (5 fingers, make a buzzing as “bees” fly away or tickle baby)

I Have a Turtle (baby either laying on floor or sitting in lap)

I have a little turtle that lives in a box (draw a “box’ with your hands in the air)

He swims across the puddles and climbs up the rocks (take hand and swim it in the air, and climb over other hand)

He snaps at the mosquito and he snaps at the flea (pretend to pick things off babies' shirt)

He snaps at the minnow and he snaps at me!

He caught the mosquito and he caught the flea (hold a hand on either side of babies' torso, and wiggle each time you ‘catch’

He caught the minnow , but he didn't catch me (big kisses or hug)
